

True Transparency in Xchat

With all the beryl goodness going around I felt it my IRC window should look nice also. I could use a terminal IRC client but I like Xchat, the only problem is the fake transparency.

With a few Google searches I came across a post to the Xchat forums and it was the answer I needed. First we will need the Xchat source.

```
$ wget http://www.xchat.org/files/source/2.8/xchat-2.8.2.tar.bz2 $ tar xjf xchat-2.8.2.tar.bz2
```

Next move into the fe-gtk directory and get the patch. Then compile and install.

```
$ cd xchat-2.8.2/src/fe-gtk $ wget http://www.regicide666.com/xchat-alpha.patch $ patch -u < xchat-alpha.patch $ cd ..../ $ ./configure $ make # make install
```

When you start Xchat go to Settings -> Preferences and check Transparent Background. To set the background color in the Preferences menu select the Color tab and change the Text Colors Background option.
